Revelation 13:11-18

I. What occurs in the book of Revelation will literally take place because God says it will. III. The False Prophet's deception leads to having complete control over mankind. They will either willingly obey him, or they will be forced to obey him, they have no choice. The choice of having a nominal faith or being a carnal believer no longer exists. A half-hearted commitment to Christ or the raising of the hand to get saved without any serious intent of living for him is not an option. It will be, either I believe the gospel and worship Christ knowing that it could lead to sure death, or I believe the Antichrist and worship him. *It's an either-or proposition with no turning back.*
